Both types can be designed with a variety of deck board configurations – tops and bottoms, number, width, overhang, and spacing. In addition, plywood or oriented strand board (OSB) can be used as deck material (otherwise known as a “panel deck” pallet).

Stringer pallets

The most common pallet in the United States. The Grocery Manufacturer Association's 48" x 40" hardwood stringer pallet specification is widely used for many consumer products. Stringers may be notched to allow partial four-way fork entry, and we can chamfer bottom deckboards for pallet jacks.

Block pallets

Block pallets are true 4-way entry pallets. They use blocks of solid wood, plywood, or plastic to support the unit load. Typically, block pallets use 4 to 12 blocks to support the top deckboards. We can manufacture them with or without bottom deckboards, or a full-perimeter base.

Special pallets

For special shipping or phytosanitary needs, we can help you with plastic pallets, 100% plywood pallets, or custom slip sheets or warehouse pallets. Just ask us!
